I upgraded a stand-alone system from AIX 4.3.3 (ML 10) to AIX 5.1 (ML 4) earlier today. The migration was performed with the CDs. Since the upgrade, error log entries (at least those I have seen so far) no longer contain "meaningful" text under the DESCRIPTION heading, only four digit codes. For example, two that I get routinely on this particular server have identifiers of A7AB4C8F and E507DCF9. On AIX 4.3.3, these would be accompanied by the descriptive text "TAPE_MIM_SIM_RECORD" and "TAPE_DRIVE_CLEANSING", respectively. Now, the former displays the code AAA0 and the latter display the code AAA2. Does anyone know how I can "instruct" the error logger to report the descriptive text again instead of these codes? TIA for any and all information.
