try this:

```
instfix -i | grep ML
```

you should get an output like this:

```
All filesets for 5.1.0.0_AIX_ML were found.  
All filesets for 5100-01_AIX_ML were found.  
All filesets for 5100-02_AIX_ML were found.  
All filesets for 5100-03_AIX_ML were found.
```

This will help you more, because it gives you the status for all maintenance levels existing in your machine.
