When I run `lscfg -vp` I get the following output:

0519-004 libodm: The specified search criteria is incorrectly formed.  
Make sure the criteria contains only valid descriptor names and  
the search values are correct.

The ailing device was `lpfc0`. I tried `diag -a` and would delete it, but it  
wouldn't go away.

I eventually hammered it out of the odm with:

```
odmdelete -q "name=lpfc0" -o CuAt
```

```
odmdelete -q "name=lpfc0" -o CuDv
```

My `bos.rte.diag` and `bos.rte.odm` are both at 4.3.3.77

I reran `cfgmgr` and I still can't run `lscfg` without errors.
