I have downloaded an AIX patch for bos.net.tcp.client 5.1.0.63. This fix loaded without a problem on our p650. I am trying to load up the same fix on an F50 disaster recovery box - but the system is giving me the message:

I ran the same procedure ("smit update_all" and it worked fine on the p650.
On the DR box I ran the `lspp -l bos.net.tcp.client` and received the following response:
