Awhile back I had setup a test volume group for our DBA, and I'm now having problems removing it. We had a server crash a short time ago when my boss made a change on the SAN which knocked offline all the logical drives assigned to the db server, so I'm guessing my current problems are related to that.

Anyway, here's what I get when I try to remove the volume group so that I can remove the hdisk:
