> *tctl fsf 3 # move the tape to the data section*
> *restore -xvf /dev/rmt0 /home # restore the files.*

Try this:

```
tctl fsf 3 /dev/rmt0.1  
restore -xvf /dev/rmt0.1 ./home
```
