Dear list,

I'd like to see what files a process is accessing. When using lsof (version 4.61 from the Linux toolbox) on an AIX 5.2 ML5 machine it shows me the filesystems the open files are in but not the actual files, for example <SNIP>

I know in UNIX everything is a file ;-) but: Can someone point me to the right usage of lsof in AIX?
