- > *Just for the purpose of making the mksysb, do the next:*

- > *1. move the /usr/lib/methods/chgfcpararray to another name*
- > *2. create an empty file named /usr/lib/methods/chgfcpararray*
- > *(#touch /usr/lib/methods/chgfcpararray or*
- > *# > /usr/lib/methods/chgfcpararray)*
- > *3. Create the mksysb*
- > *4. Test the mksysb*
- > *5. Return the file /usr/lib/methods/chgfcpararray*

I'll try to find time tomorrow to verify that the backup works as expected and let you all know if I run into any problems at all.
