I'm using some batch jobs that send some huge files (around 40GB or more) to a Windows server. At some point of time (not specific), the job is aborted. I'm having some troubles, because it is necessary to run those jobs again and I spend much of time. The Windows support team searched for some related problems and there's no issue regarding AIX to Windows FTP transfer. The network is also ok.
