> *At every bootup, snmpd starts up – causing a performance issue, because of a conflict with oracle agent.*

>

You can use 'smit tcpip' and further configuration to disable services, or you can edit '/etc/rc.tcpip' and comment out the 'start snmpd' line near the bottom of the file. Comments start with '#' in this file.
