(a) Mac OS X has cvs installed out of the box, in /usr/bin/cvs. It's version 1.11.20, which is a good bit **more** recent than the version 1.11.17 that FreeBSD is still using (why? incompatibilities with developers' pet scripts?)

Because we have thousands of lines of changes to CVS that need careful merging. We generally apply the security patches instead unless there has been a compelling feature we need.
