I believe we should make the default 64k, and let other platforms, like arm, use DEFAULTS to change it to smaller values if necessary...

Better idea:

```
if (ram <= 16MB)
msgbuf_size = 8k
else if (ram <= 64MB)
msgbuf_size = 16k
else if (ram <= 512MB)
msgbuf_size = 32k
else
msgbuf_size = 64k
```
