For similar reasons, I would like to ask for including the option INCLUDE\_CONFIG\_FILE by default in GENERIC. It only requires about 10 KB of space, but it can be extremely helpful. I've quite often seen people asking how to recover their kernel configuration (e.g. lost during an update). INCLUDE\_CONFIG\_FILE would have saved their day ...

Seconded. Was about to propose that myself.

All (about 100) FreeBSD machines I manage have a custom kernel with this option always added. So please add my Yeah vote to the list.
