>*From perforce log:*

XXX Propagate hack from UFS: open device for write access even if the user requests a read-only mount. This is fairly stupid, but it's necessary because we don't do the VOP_OPEN again if they upgrade a read-only mount to read-write.

Fixes lockup when creating files on msdosfs mounts that have been mounted read-only then upgraded to read-write, reported by andreas@.
