I just set up a test server running FreeBSD-5.1 with pam\_ldap and nss\_ldap for authentication.

It works really nice so far.

I have a little question though: I wanted the user homedir to be created the first time a user logs in if it does not exist. I know I need pam\_mkhome for this but I can't find it under 5.1.

If I remember, pam\_mkhome was in the contrib section under 4.x. Any idea why it is not part of FreeBSD anymore ? Or do you know any other way of auto-creating users homedir ?
