Hi,

I'm not sure if this is a known problem, but I don't see any references to it. I've gone from 5.1-RELEASE to today's CURRENT to try to get rid of a different panic (no news on that yet), but I have hit this one.

If I boot my system with no floppy in the LS-120, the system panics where atapicam creates da0 for it. If there is a disk in the drive, it works fine.

As yet, I haven't got the details of the panic, but if this is of interest to anyone here, I will be willing to provide them with them (they will have to be copied out by hand, so I'm loathe to do it if nobody is interested).
