I'm not sure what's causing these ACPI problems in this recent -CURRENT, but I've found where it's hanging. It's on this line:

```
as = AcpiEvaluateObject(h, "_BIF", NULL, &bif_buffer);
```

in `acpi_cmbat.c` in `sys/dev/acpica/`. The function `AcpiEvaluateObject` is found in `contrib/dev/acpica/nsxfeval.c`, which hasn't changed in a while. I tried adding a line to print out 'h', but I wasn't sure what to try to show it as. Printing it as an integer gave a weird negative value.

What, exactly, should I be looking for here?
