> *I've just committed changes that modify the format of LC_CTYPE*

> *files. Next time when you buildworld/installworld, please do*

> *it without -DNO_CLEAN, or at least remove the contents of*

> */usr/obj/usr/src/share/mklocale/.*

Usually nothing wrong happens even without those measures. If LC_CTYPE file format is different enough, the reader function returns error and locale stays to "C". The only case left if it is different in small part so reader function can't detect the difference. I don't look at your changes yet to say one or another for sure.
