Hi,

I switched the timecounter used to use the TSC instead of the ACPI one (/etc/sysctl.conf). After rebooting powerd refused to start. I removed the line which changes the timecounter in sysctl.conf and powerd starts again.

Is this expected, or is this a bug?

If this is expected:

- powerd fails with an unhelpful message
- this isn't documented in the man-page (at least not in -current as of 2-3 weeks ago)
