```
# time ./settimetest

INFO: settimeofday completed sucessfully
INFO: Reset time to original value
0.000u 0.002s 0:00.00 0.0% 0+0k 0+0io 0pf+0w
```

Oops – thought I was reading –stable instead of –current list (doh).. sorry! Well at least you know it can work on \*some\* version of FreeBSD!....(I don't have any machines running –current at the moment to test).
