Ulrich Spoerlein wrote:

at least msdosfs and cd9660 do not fill the birthtime for the stat(2) syscall. Thus stat(1) will return different values per call:

[...]

The code in cd9660_getattr() and msdosfs_getattr() should be augmented. But what value to put into the field? Clearly, a constant would be preferred instead of an uninitialized value.

Please see PR kern/106018. It fixes the msdosfs case; it has already been committed a few weeks ago.

I haven't looked at the cd9660 code, but if you see similar problems there, then I guess it needs a similar fix. ;-)
