Hi!

I'm attempting to upgrade a server to amd64 CURRENT from an older snapshot. I have "MODULES_OVERRIDE= acpi" in make.conf but apparently only the acpi_*.ko files are being built, not acpi.ko itself. As a result, acpi.ko is not being loaded on boot.

On amd64 (and ia64) acpi is compiled in the the kernel rather than built as a module.
