> *FreeBSD-5.x so I'm confused about how I talk to this audio chip.*

I'm an idiot, I didn't have "pcm" in my kernel. :-(

I added "device pcm" to my kernel and now devices like dsp0[W].[0-5] and audio0.[0-5] appear in /dev and I've got audio.

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
