The default configuration doesn't expose sendmail to the publicly visible IP address. The daemon it runs only listens for connections to the localhost address.

Unfortunately, in jails, localhost gets remapped to the jail IP address and therefore, he is correct, it is accepting connections from the outside world. This is one thing that I would love to see fixed in jails.

So you must use a specific submit.mc/.cf pointing to the correct MSP IP, not to 127.0.0.1.
