You should type "make clean" more often. ;-)

And to ensure that 'make clean' in the /usr/ports directory runs much faster, be sure to add NOCLEANDEPENDS=YES in your /etc/make.conf.

After you run that on the entire tree be sure to comment it out so that when you run make clean inside a port you clean all the dependancies too.
