Because the information is not a constant. For example, the mpg123 port changes its PKGNAME as soon as esound is installed.

Maybe the time has come to give up on some of the flexibility the ports tree has (and this particular one is confusing to the users) [...]

maybe more confusing to portupgrade -- one day I'll get tired of running 'pkgdb -F' almost every time before portupgrade to fix old dependencies (packages with old config or things like ru-xmms instead of xmms). This is portupgrade's problem really, but doing away from such "flexibility" would make life slightly easier...
