I install the Natd in my Internet gateway to access Internet and the Internet access my ftp server into my network.

I do the steps at the

To information: In my internal network the FTP functioned perfectly (is a Linux Enterprise WS Server).

My file /etc/natd.conf is:

```
-redirect_port tcp 192.168.1.1:20 20
```

```
-redirect_port tcp 192.168.1.1:21 21
```

My inicialization command is: `/sbin/natd -s -interface xl0 -config /etc/natd.conf`

My ipfw configuration file is:

```
/sbin/ipfw add 0001 divert 8668 all from 192.168.1.0/24 to any via xl0 out
```

```
/sbin/ipfw add 0002 divert 8668 all from any to 200.x.x.x via xl0 in
```
