>ppp setup but it seems that ng_iface doesn't have any AltQ hooks :(

>I had a look at it to see if they could be retrofitted but alas it appears the
>ng_iface driver is not very much like others (ie no queueing of packets?) so
>it would need more work..
>
>I could use ppp(8) and do queueing on tun, but I would prefer to use mpd as
>all of the packet movement is in the kernel which makes sense to me.
>
>Does anyone have any patches
