> *ata1-slave: FAILURE – ATAPI_IDENTIFY timed out also it takes alot of*
> *time to load uhub1. I am trying to dualboot it with Windows XP but I*
> *dont think thats a problem because I installed it on my home computer*
> *without any problems (also dualbooted and the same FreeBSD cd).*

> *After searching though the mailing list archives I tried the following:*
> *At the boot prompt of the FreeBSD cd I went into the loader prompt and*
> *did typed the following "set hw.ata.atapi_dma="0"" after that I typed*
> *"boot" to continue booting up the installation. Yet it still hangs at*
> *the same point.*

> *I was hoping someone could help me getting it to boot so I can install*
> *it on my laptop.*

Try installing it in safe mode. After you have installed it in safe mode, edit /boot/defaults/loader.conf. Comment out everything that handles acpi. Then add add this hint.apic.0.disabled="1"
