> *For my small programming project on this home FreeBSD box I created a*
> */home/cvs directory where I intend to store the files related to the*
> *st4nk project and added myself to the cvs group. I ran the cvs init*
> *and cvs import commands to get my project up and running. This is the*
> *directory structure I'm left with:*

> */home/cvs/st4nk/CVSROOT* <- created when I did the cvs init command
> */home/cvs/st4nk/st4nk* <- created when I did the cvs import command
>
> *all my project related files and subdirectories wound up in the*
> */home/cvs/st4nk/st4nk subdirectory. So it looks like it all worked*
> *out, yes?*
