Posting this here so I can find it next time I need. Converts files in a directory to lower-case, change "\*.TTF" to whatever you want to find / change:

```
find ./ -name "*.TTF" -exec perl -e 'rename($_, lc) || warn "$_: $!\n"'
for @ARGV' {} \;
```

Alternatively you can use "find ./ -type f" to change ALL files in the current working directory.
