No! Socket AM2 is the DDR2 939-pin Athlon64 desktop replacement.  
Socket F(1207) is DDR2 the 940-pin Opteron server replacement.

Same crap, different pins. The change simply allows AMD cpus to use DDR2 memory, nothing more.

Getting off topic now but I'd submit to you that a 1207 pin vs 940 pin is setting up for the access requirements of quad core something that AM2 is not going to be capable of hence quite different indeed.
