but I tell you that a 10K Raptor is faster then a 15K 320Mb SCSI when compiling world or untarring large files.

Well, put that '10K Raptor' in a loaded fileserver and compare it with a SCSI thing. Most scsi implementations I know are much more scalable when there's a realworld load sucking it till death. Try it ;-)
