hi guys,

portaudit reperoted a vulnerability on the ruby package, so i did the following:

```
# cvsup -L 2 ports-supfile
# portsdb -Uu
# portupgrade -rR ruby
```

but i encountered this error message, i can't upgrade ruby.

```
---> Upgrading 'ruby-1.8.4_8,1' to 'ruby-1.8.4_9,1' (lang/ruby18)
---> Building '/usr/ports/lang/ruby18'
===> Cleaning for ruby-1.8.4_9,1
```

**NOTE:**

You can enable pthread support by defining WITH\_PTHREADS variable, but not recommended since this might break some ruby apps.

I'm not 100% sure on this, but I think the problem is that even the new Ruby port has the vulnerabilities in it. You won't be able to upgrade until those get patched first. This is the first ML message I've seen about this issue, so I don't have any more info.
