On 16/12/06 Michael P. Soulier said:

```
Stop in /usr/ports/lang/ruby18.  
** Command failed [exit code 1]: /usr/bin/script -qa /tmp/portupgrade12405.0  
make PORT_UPGRADE=yes reinstall  
egrep: /var/db/pkg/ruby-1.8.4_9,1/+CONTENTS: No such file or directory  
----> Restoring the old version
```

Any ideas why?

So, the logs tell me why.

```
swap_pager_getswapspace(9): failed  
swap_pager_getswapspace(9): failed  
swap_pager_getswapspace(2): failed  
swap_pager_getswapspace(3): failed  
swap_pager_getswapspace(2): failed  
swap_pager_getswapspace(2): failed

```

I guess ruby used too much memory for my system.
