So I just installed a new terabyte WD drive and I am showing 902GB on the new drive, which I expect thank to the fact they use 1000 instead of 1024. However the problem I am seeing is that I am losing 72Gb from the start on the fresh drive.

As you can see I am using 0% however I have already lost 72Gb. Is there a flag I am missing for newfs for new large drives or is this a bug with df.
