When I plug it in:

```
umass0: Apple Inc. iPod, rev 2.00/0.01, addr 2
da0 at umass-sim0 bus 0 target 0 lun 0
da0: <Apple iPod 1.62> Removable Direct Access SCSI-0 device
da0: 40.000MB/s transfers
da0: 7583MB (1941441 4096 byte sectors: 255H 63S/T 120C)
```

I have another MP3 player, not an Ipod. But for me, it works to mount /dev/da0sX instead of /dev/da0 (X is usually 1).

Sometimes it's even not enough, in my case:

```
# ls /dev/da1*
/dev/da1

# mount_msdosfs /dev/da1 /mnt/tmp/
mount_msdosfs: /dev/da1: : Invalid argument

# ls /dev/da1*
/dev/da1 /dev/da1s1

# mount_msdosfs /dev/da1s1 /mnt/tmp/
#
```

Slice one doesn't appear until you try to access da1...
