I've setup a new web server hostname doremi.ctgameinfo.com. When I try to send mail to [username@xxxxxxxxxxxxxxxx](mailto:username@xxxxxxxxxxxxxxxx) it tries to deliver it locally instead of to the mx server mx1.ctgameinfo.com.

In previous versions this seems to work correctly. Why would it be trying to deliver locally this time? I'm running default sendmail config that comes with the standard install.

Show us your `/etc/mail/hostname.mc` file, and if you have a file with a list of `local` hostnames in `/etc/mail/local-host-names` show us that file too.
