my ports database seems to have become broken. I'm running -stable, but haven't rebuilt the system in a year or so (I know, security vulnerabilities, but the box has been shelved in this time).

anyhow, at this point, I can't do even a make clean in ports, or build portupgrade. I fetched portupgrade with pkg\_add hoping that running pkgdb -F would sort things out, but it errors with:
