And no i will not change to linux, i was just hoping if anyone could tell me if i have set anything wrong. In xmms i'm forced to use esound output plugin to be able to set volume. And i believe i'm using the right audio output line, because other ones didnt work. So has anyone else encoutered problems like this?
