> *What should I do to avoid this error?*

Try changing the amount of time that attributes are cached for with the `acregmin/acregmax/acdirmin/acdirmax` options to `mount_nfs`. Setting them all to 1 might be a place to start. This won't eliminate the problem entirely, but it may make it occur less often.
