In local.freebsd-stable, you wrote:

- > *I see similar errors repeatably on non-gnome ports on bento, e.g.*
- > http://bento.freebsd.org/errorlogs/i386-4-full/iiimf-csconv-r11.4_1.log
- > *I've not been able to track down what is calling rcmdsh [1], let alone why*
- > *it's failing.*

Just to add a data point in case somebody wants to look at this:

Looks like a smashed stack: gdb'ing drops you dead in libc's _start() when you get back from the "call main", if you use "exit" instead of "return" in main, something else goes wrong...Interestingly, the problem goes away when linking with ElectricFence.
