>
> *I noticed it about a week ago. My local hosts have suffering*
> *such delays while connecting to the (imho) tcp-wrapped services,*
> *namely ssh, smtp, mysql.*
> *It looks like the addresses to names resolving. I don't need to resolve my*
> *local names or addresses now. There was not any delays early.*
> *But they have appeared without any visable reason.*
>
> *What could to involve a such system behaviour?*
> *How should I return my system to previous state?*
>
> *P.S. I will not want neither to edit the /etc/hosts file nor create*
> *and maintain dns-zones for the internal hosts.*

I don't see any changes to the tcpwrappers services. Check resolv.conf; maybe one of the listed nameservers is down or unresponsive?

You really should have machines in DNS or /etc/hosts, but if you don't want to maintain that, then you suffer the consequences.
