I see, seems to be my fault. I only use "make world/make kernel" and 'hoped' those makefile do the rest for me – without having proved it for myself. Sorry for bothering ...

This evening I'll check that and I'm sure, as you can see in the error message, there is still the old location 'active' ...

Use of "make world" is very, very dangerous unless you know exactly what you are doing and the exact state of your sources. There are many, myself included who would like to see the target removed.

In any case, stick to the procedure un /usr/src/UPDATING if you really want things to build correctly.
