Hi,

I've just cvsup'd my Latitude D820 laptop with a Broadcom BCM5752 to the latest 6-STABLE, and I seem to be experiencing some problems with the dhcp client on the base system. The dhcp-client program fails to request an IP address from the DHCP server running isc-dhcp3-server. With a Windows based DHCP server, it succeeds more often, but seems to fail perhaps 1 out of 10 times. I thought it could be the NIC itself, but when booting under Windows, there doesn't seem to be any problems with the Windows DHCP client requesting an IP address from either the Windows DHCP server or ISC-DHCP server.

Is anyone else seeing this?

I have a similar issue with FreeBSD RELENG\_6 with ndis it fails to request dns requests from the ADSL Wireless router.

It fails 5/10 I have to keep pressing F5 in FF 2 to re request dns again and again.
