On current it just has a different bug :)

If you have hundreds of md devices then mdconfig -l lists no devices.

I'm about to fix this.

Anyway it is probably just a simple MFC to fix, so why not find out who committed the change to current and ask them about it?

I committed changes related with proper mdconfig(8) interface to -CURRENT, but I'm not able to test them on RELENG\_6 right now.

Please let me know if anyone is willing to test such changes on RELENG\_6.
