The machine will freeze hard a few seconds after powerd is started up by the rc script. With kern.smp.disabled=1, everything seems to work fine. This is with today's 6-STABLE/i386. I see that a fix for that sort of thing was only recently MFC'd, unfortunately I cannot say whether the problem was already there before it went in – the box is brand new.

I have the same problem with a dual Opteron (RELENG_6_2, i386 and amd64), in my case the following workaround helped:

from "/boot/loader.conf":

```
hint.acpi_throttle.0.disabled="1"
```

Thanks! Unfortunately it does not help here – but with that, it takes a few seconds longer for the freeze to occur.
