I have a number of HP-UX servers that I administer remotely. I would like to use `make_net_recovery` on them however I cannot guarantee there will be a tape available.

Is there a method to create a bootable image of the running system on disk, transfer that image to on an ignite server and then re-install by doing a network install?

I suspect, if it is possible, it will use `make_sys_image`, `make_medialif` maybe `instl_combine` however I would be grateful if someone has already gone through the pain they could pass on the method they came up with.
