I have a surprizing problem that manifested itself right after the reboot: "last" command fails with "memory fault(coredump)" message. What could be the problem, how to fix it? "who" works just fine. L2000 HP-UX 11.0.

> *Sounds like corruption of the wtmp file. Make a copy of /var/adm/wtmp*
> *then zero the wtmp file and reboot. It may be a patch issue but I did*
> *not see anything in the patch database.*
