> *request, Start restore, Restore to other clients, Restore from other*  
> *users and See private objects. I would assume this just alows them to*  
> *restore data and control that restore process.*  
>  
> *The problem is that they are just users and will only need to do*  
> *restores on 2 win2k servers but all the servers are listed in their*  
> *restore view. We want to minimise the risk of mistakes (the server names*  
> *are all very similar) and only allow them to see their 2 servers.*

> *Is there any way to do this?*
